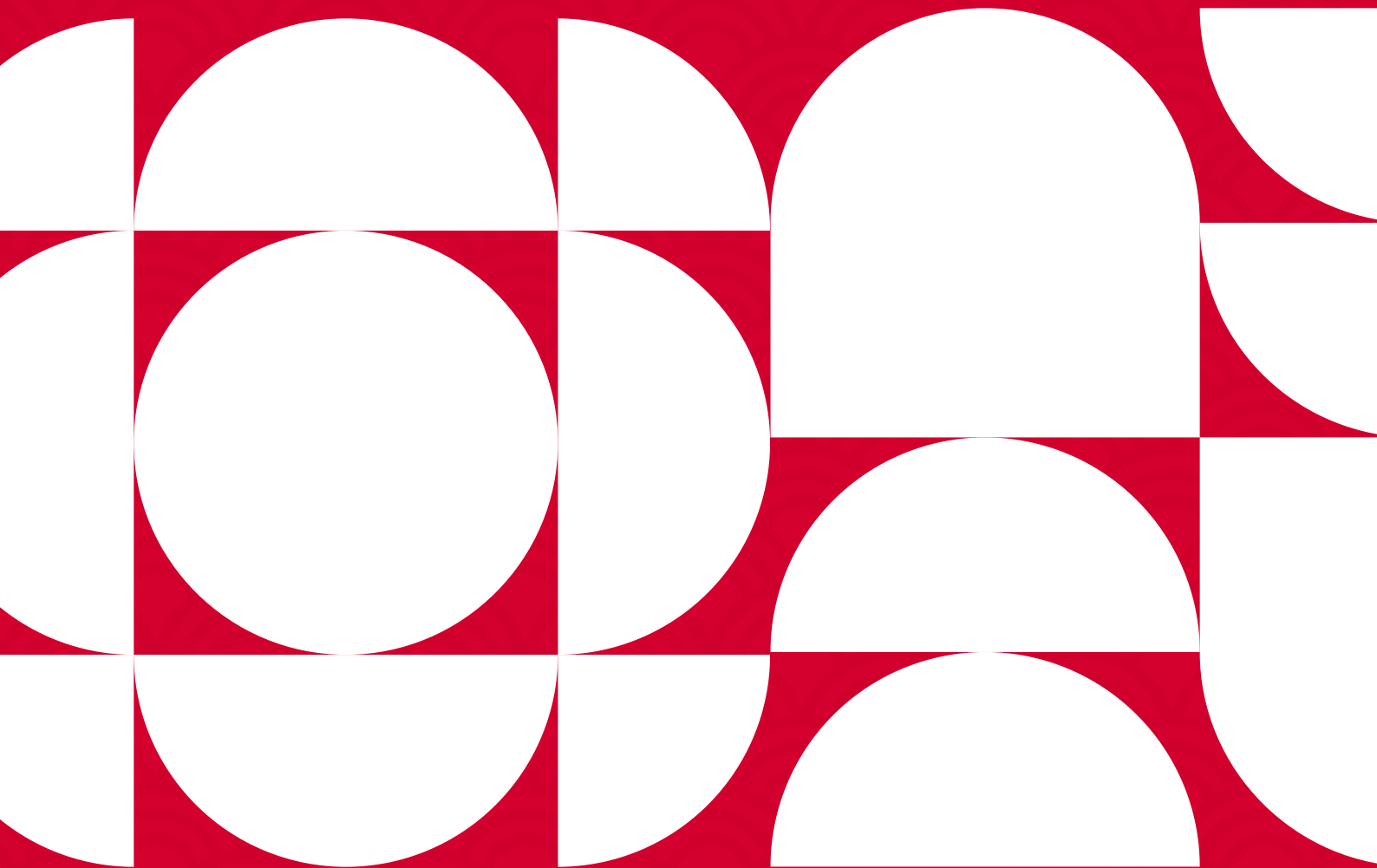


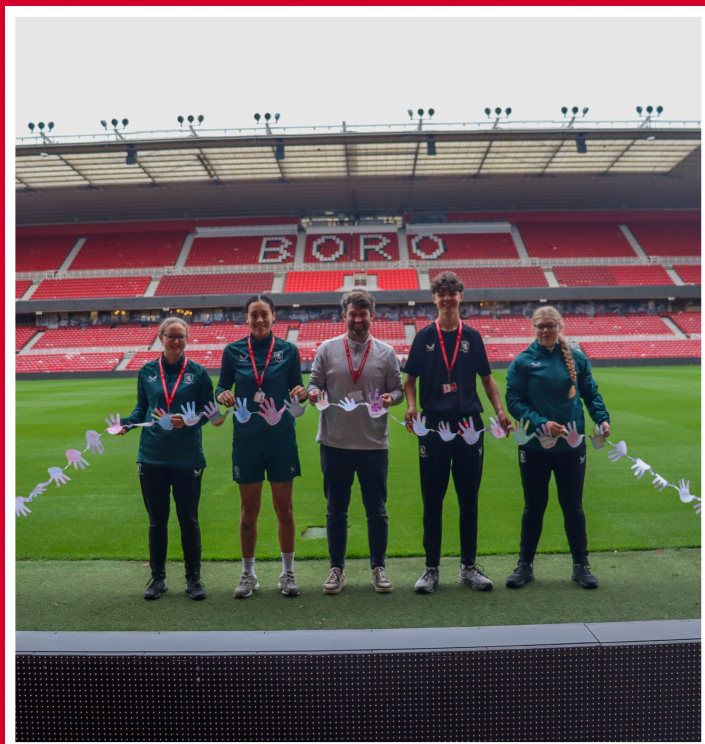

Aims



The Youth Panel exists to:

- Provide a platform for young people to influence Middlesbrough Football Club Foundation's work
- Ensure youth voice is embedded in decision-making across programmes
- Support the Foundation's mission to positively impact communities across the Tees Valley



Membership



The recruitment process:

- Up to 14 young activators, aged 16 - 24
- Recruited through an open application process
- Membership is voluntary and lasts for one year, with the option to renew

Meetings



- Held four times per year during school half terms: October, February, April, and July
- Facilitated by Foundation staff and may include guest speakers, workshops, and project planning
- It is the responsibility of the meeting facilitator to ensure that all supervisor and safeguarding, health and safety procedures are put in place



Responsibilities



- Attend and actively participate in scheduled meetings
- Share ideas, feedback, and lived experiences to shape Foundation programmes
- Represent the views of young people in the Tees Valley
- Work collaboratively with panel members and staff
- Uphold the values of Middlesbrough Football Club Foundation

Roles



Middlesbrough Football Club Foundation staff members will facilitate all meetings.

The Youth Panel are recruiting positions associated with running the panel, including:

- Chair – leading discussion and ensuring meetings stay on track
- Minute Taker – recording meeting notes and decisions

Resolutions & Voting

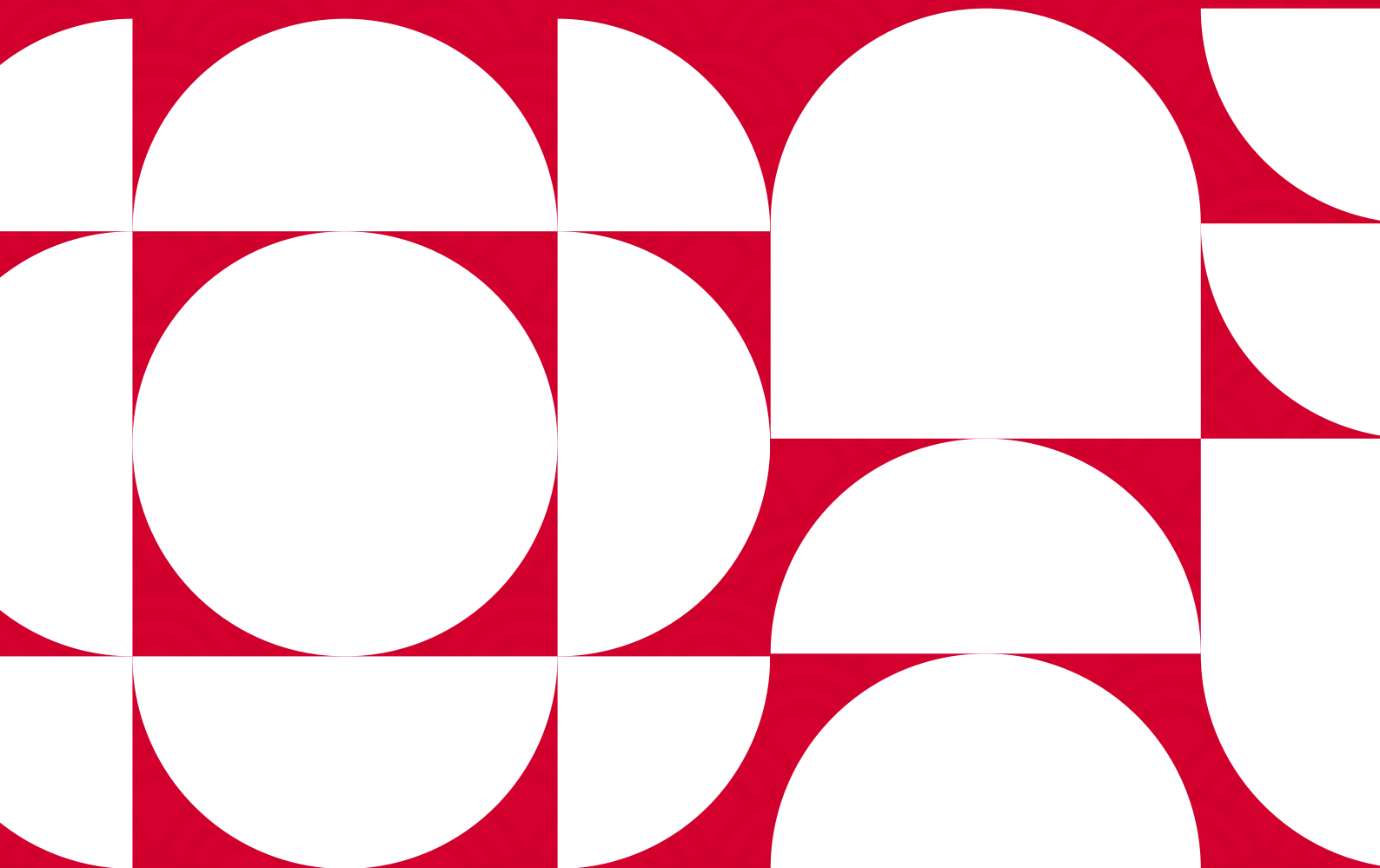


Decisions of the panel will be taken after a discussion and recorded within the minutes of the meeting when a resolution is passed.
